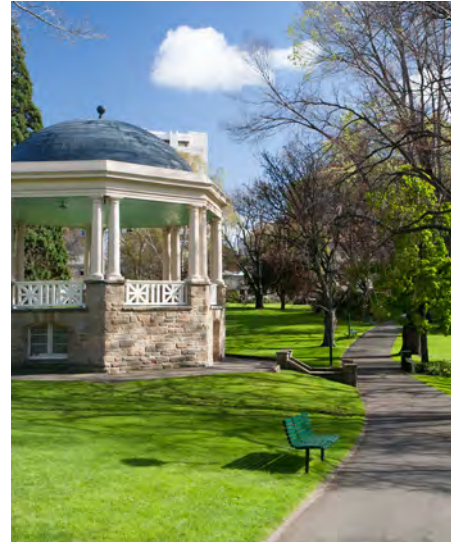

HOBART & BEYOND

- Check out the famous **Salamanca Markets** (every Saturday)

- Visit the **Museum of Old and New Art (MONA)**
- Catch a bus or drive up to **Mt Wellington Summit** and pop into Australia's oldest brewery, **Cascade Brewery**, at the foot of the mountain afterwards.

THE SOUTHERN EDGE

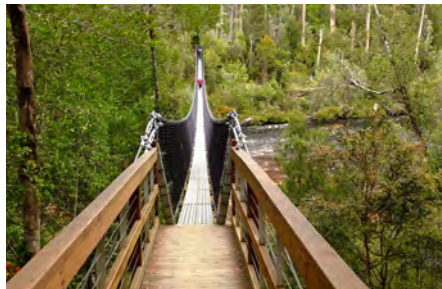
HIGHLIGHTS

- Take trip to **Bruny Island** to check out the dramatic coastline of **Adventure Bay**, indulge at the Bruny Island **chocolate factory** and spot some of the local **wildlife**
- Go underground and explore the caves and thermal springs of the **Hastings Caves State Reserve**. A tour of the Newdegate Cave is a must!
- Go for a walk in the **Hartz Mountains National Park**. There's a few short and accessible trails, including Arve Falls and Waratah Lookout
- Stop by **Huonville** to browse the little shops or sign up for white-water rafting for more action

TASMAN PENINSULA

HIGHLIGHTS

- Follow the Convict Trail to Port Arthur and stop at the historic town of **Richmond**
- Visit the **Port Arthur** open-air museum. The ruins of the former penitentiary and Convict Church are a listed UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Take a boat trip over to **Maria Island**, the historic convict island which is now a National Park and known for its wildlife. You can spot possums, wallabies and rare birds here
- Dive the Tasman Peninsula! The **underwater world** here is incredibly diverse. Encounter fur seals, see weedy seadragons, explore the SS `Nord` wreck and the famous Cathedral Cave

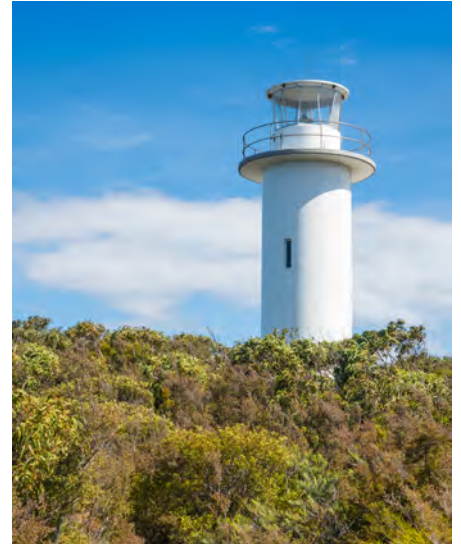

FREYCINET PENINSULA

HIGHLIGHTS

- Base yourself in **Coles Bay** for a couple of days to explore the peninsula and national park
- Hike up to the **Wineglass Bay** Lookout to catch the best views of the famous white sand beach. For even better views, you can take a scenic flight across the peninsula.
- The **Freycinet National Park** is a highlight! Pick up a map of the park at the visitor centre and head out to explore the landscape of red rocks, wild flowers and deep blue water.
- Take a **cruise** to Wineglass Bay or go sea kayaking for the day
- Visit **Cape Tourville Lighthouse** and enjoy the stunning views and check out **Bluestone Bay**

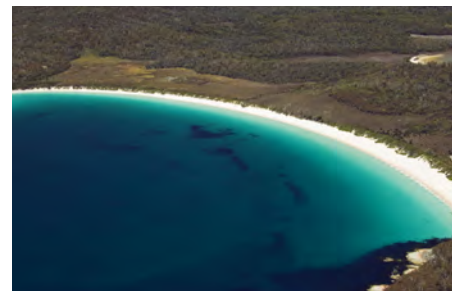

SURF COAST

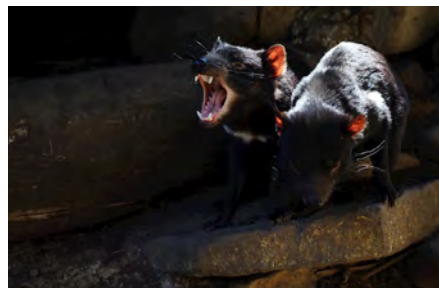
HIGHLIGHTS

- **Surf** on the coast between Bicheno and Beaumaris, known for its year-round reliable swell
- Join a **whale watching** cruise or take a guided tour so see little penguins or Tasmanian devils
- Drive inland to explore the forests and waterfalls of **Douglas Apsley National Park**. You can choose between short walks or the full-day Rainforest Circuit
- SCUBA dive the **Governor Island Marine Reserve** which has some of Australia's best dive sites, including Paradise Reef and Magic Garden

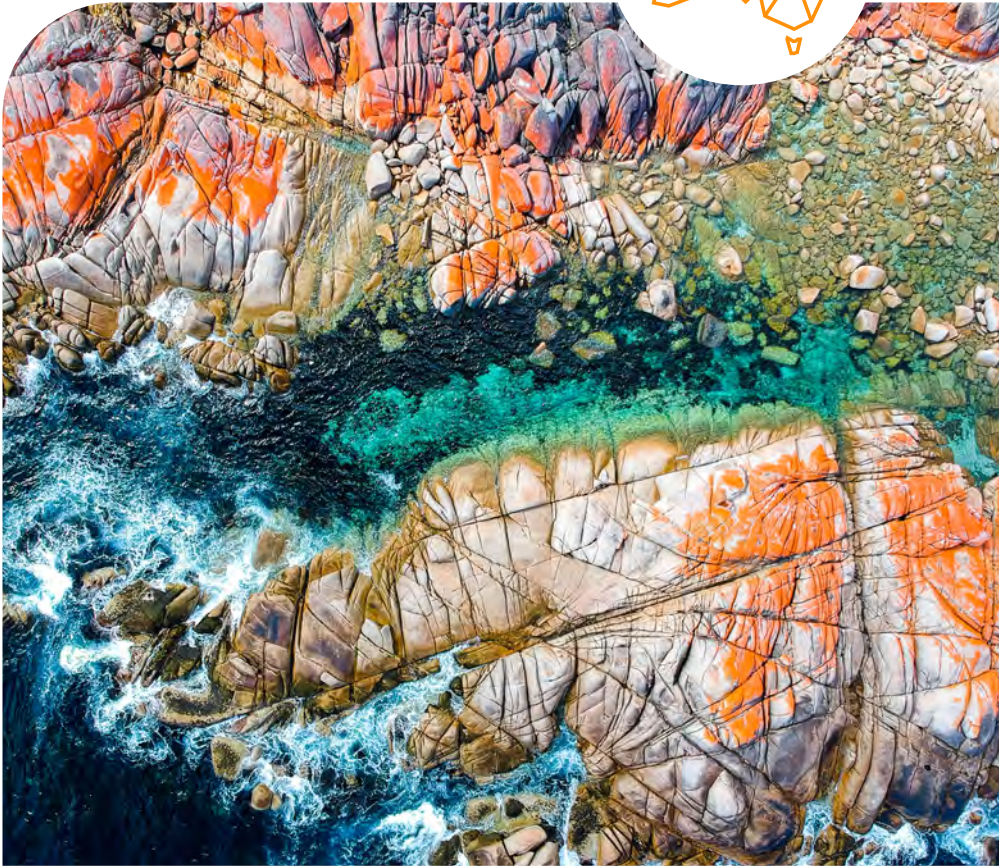

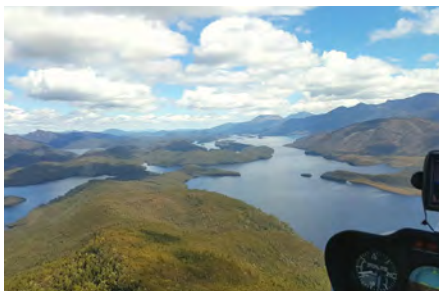


THE WESTERN WILDERNESS

- Head to the old mining settlement of **Corinna**, hire a kayak to explore the network of rivers and stop by Lovers Falls in the **Pieman River**
- See the beautiful lake Roseberry and **Montezuma Falls**
- Have a picnic at the **Henty Sand Dunes** and follow the 1.5-hour trail to Tassie's longest beach
- Visit the old fishing town of **Strahan** and join a **cruise down Gordon River**
- Learn about Tasmania's mining history in **Queenstown** and drive up to **Iron Blowout Lookout**

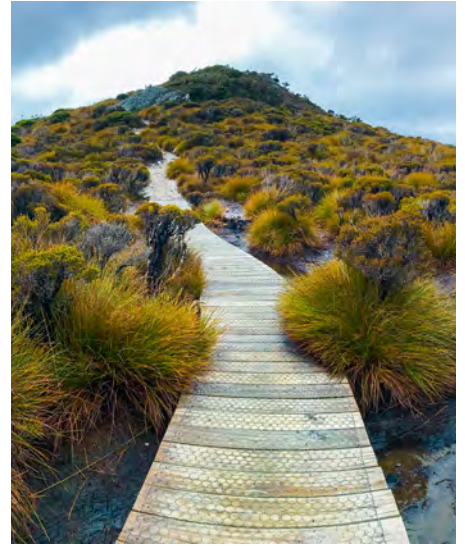

THE CRADLE HINTERLAND

HIGHLIGHTS

- Get ready for one of Tasmania's top attractions: **Cradle Mountain Nationalpark**
- Speak to the staff at the National Park Office to find the best **hiking tracks** for you (ranging from 30 minutes to several days)
- Hike to Australia's deepest freshwater lake, **Lake St Clair**
- Spend some time on **Mount Field National Park** and see the famous **Russell Falls**
- Change your perspective! Take a cruise down the **Derwent River** or get in a **helicopter** to see Cradle Mountain, Crater Lake and the Waterfall Valley from above
